Take one step forward to establish a Recovery Set-Aside:

Show your support for the millions of Americans in and seeking recovery by asking Senators Hawley and Blunt to cosponsor the Substance Use Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery Act (S. 4301). This critical legislation would authorize a 10% set-aside for recovery support services in the Substance Use Block Grant – the first dedicated funding stream for recovery. Our momentum continues to grow, and your organization's action is needed - let your voice be heard!

Ask Senators Hawley and Blunt to co-sponsor S. 4301 by joining this letter campaign. Add your own message or simply send our template letter. I suggest you begin the letter by explaining a little bit about your organization. The same letter will go to both Senators. Select "health/healthcare" as the subject of the letter when prompted to do so.

## Medicaid's Presumptive Eligibility

Presumptive Eligibility has been added to Missouri's Medicaid information online. "Presumptive Eligibility allows specially trained health care providers, known as Qualified Entities (QE), to make Presumptive Eligibility determinations. This makes it possible for eligible individuals to gain immediate access to medical services for a temporary period of time, during which they should submit an application to be processed for ongoing Medicaid coverage."


