OVERDOSE AWARENESS EVENT

MCRSP held a booth at Recovery Lighthouse's 4th annual Overdose Awareness Day event on August 31, 2024, at the Pettis County Courthouse Lawn in Sedalia. The event featured several key speakers: Christine Smith, Director of Prevention and Crisis Services at the Department of Mental Health, who discussed 988 and other crisis services; Missouri Representative Brad Pollitt, who provided an update on legislative actions in Jefferson City to

address the opioid epidemic; and Pettis County Sheriff Brad Anders, who explained the application of the Good Samaritan Law within his department.

Additionally, Courtnee Chartier, MPS, MRSS, conducted a Narcan training and demonstration, equipping attendees with crucial skills to effectively respond to opioid overdoses. This event successfully combined informative presentations with practical training to enhance community knowledge and preparedness.

MINI-GRANTS

The Missouri Coalition of Recovery Support Providers receives \$30,000 annually from the Missouri Department of Mental Health to help community organizations host local events that raise awareness about substance use, break stigma, and connect individuals to essential resources. This year, our mini grant funding is being allocated rapidly—over half of our total \$30,000 has already been awarded. We encourage organizations to apply soon to take advantage of the remaining funds.

On August 31, 2024, Fresh Start hosted their "Together We Can!" Family Fun Day Event in observance of Overdose Awareness Day. This free event brought together local residents, the recovery community, and families Callaway County to celebrate hope and resilience while addressing the issues of addiction and stigma. The event was designed to create an inclusive and supportive environment, offering a variety of activities and resources related to brining awareness to drug usage and overdoses.

Thanks to \$1,000 in funding from the Department of Mental Health, awarded to Fresh Start by MCRSP, the event was able to offer a variety of free amenities and resources to attendees. Throughout the day, attendees were treated to free meals, giveaways, and educational booths from community partner agencies. These booths

provided valuable information and resources on addiction recovery and support services, helping to bridge gaps in knowledge and connect individuals with the tools they need to pursue their recovery journeys.
