MCRSP Executive Director Search

The search for the new MCRSP Executive Director is proceeding right along. The 16-member task force made up of MCRSP Coalition Leadership members appointed by the MCRSP Executive Board with the confirmation of the Missouri Department of Mental Health/Behavioral Health Division received 42 resumes. Those applicants were scored using criteria set forth by the task force. The top five applicants will be interviewed via Zoom, following an in-person interview with the top three applicants. The new Executive Director will be announced at the upcoming MCRSP/Recovery Coalition of the Ozarks Conference in Branson on September 11, 2023.

Legislative Priorities - 2024

The 2024 Legislative priorities will be somewhat of a repeat of 2023 due to the Governor's vetoes. MCRSP Leadership has met with Lobbyists Rich Aubuchon and Trent Watson on several occasions to set forth a plan of action that includes seeking the following:

- ~ 5% Rate Increase
- ~ Benevolent Tax Credit
